神田外語大学大学院言語科学研究科英語学専攻(修士課程)のTESOLプログラムは、主に現職教員を対象とし、外国語学習・教育の最新理論を明確に理解した上で、自らの教室実践に関して教育学的知見に基づいた意思決定を行うことのできる教育者の育成を目指します。教室現場の多様性と複雑性を認識し、教師が学習者のニーズに適切に対応するために必要な幅広い専門知識・指導法を習得するための支援を行います。さらに、自己観察と自己評価の習慣を育成することで、教師としての長期的な成長のための基盤を提供します。本課程修了者は、英語教育において先導的な役割を果たすことができる英語教育の専門家となることが期待されます。

特徴

- 日本で英語教育に携わっている英語母語話者と非母語話者を対象とします。
- 在職のまま通学が出来るように、週末と夏休みなどの特定の時期に授業を行います。
- 授業は全て英語で行われます。
- 募集は年2回です。(9月入学、4月入学)
- 通常2年～2年半で修士号を修得可能です。
- 場所は東京・神田キャンパスになります。
- 教諭一種免許状保有者は、本修士課程修了時に専修免許状の申請が可能です。

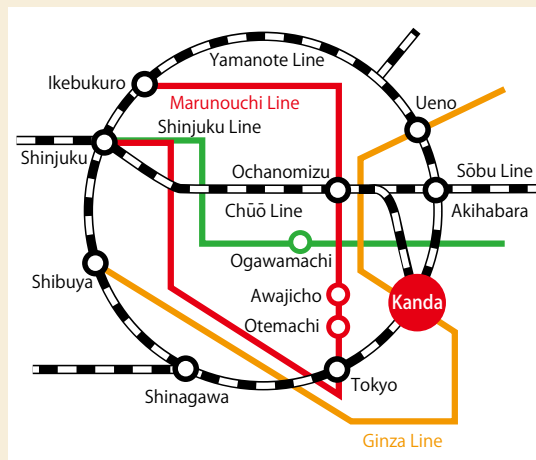

● Program Mission

The Master's Program in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) has as its mission helping teachers, both in-service and pre-service, to become reflective practitioners who can make pedagogically sound and informed decisions about their classroom practices based on a well-articulated understanding of current theories of language and second language learning and teaching. Recognizing the diversity and complexity of today's classrooms, this degree program aims to help teachers develop an extensive repertoire of instructional methods and strategies as well as professional knowledge and skills that enable them to take appropriate action to address the learning needs of their students. Furthermore, the program aims to provide a solid foundation for long-term teacher development by helping cultivate the habit of self-observation and self-evaluation. Graduates of this program will be self-directed language professionals well-prepared to take a leadership role in the community of ESOL teachers.

● Features

- This program is designed mainly for in-service teachers of English in Japan, both native and non-native speakers of English.
- Classes are held on weekends and during summer holidays.
- All classes are conducted in English.
- Students are accepted twice a year. (September & April)
- Students will be able to complete all the requirements for MA approximately in two and a half years.
- The venue is located in Kanda, Tokyo.

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- The Certificate Program can be completed in one year (two semesters).
- Students in the Certificate Program are eligible for admission to the MA Program upon their successful completion of the Certificate Program. The credits obtained from the Certificate Program count toward the MA degree.

Number of Credits

- Master of Arts (MA)
For the MA in TESOL, 37 credits are required for completion. Students are granted one to three credits toward graduation based on their previous teaching experience. Furthermore, the program accepts up to six transfer credits from other post-graduate programs in similar subjects. Holders of Cambridge DELTA and CELTA Certificates can transfer two and three credits toward this program respectively. Normally, students can complete all the requirements for graduation in 2 to 2.5 years. In principle, a 1-credit course is 12 hours, and a 3-credit course is 34 hours long.

■ Certificate Program

For the Certificate in TESOL, 13 credits are required. The KUIS Certificate TESOL Program accepts no transfer credits from other institutions. The Certificate Program can be completed in one year (two semesters).
